Springfield Campus, Queensland

UIL's main campus. Springfield is a modern, growing community conveniently located 30 minutes from the CBD of Brisbane, Queensland's capital city and less than 1 hour from the famous Gold Coast. The campus is located within Education City, a centre for quality education. As the largest master planned community in Australia, Springfield offers a safe and supportive multi-cultural community.

Cairns Campus, Queensland

In partnership with Education Queensland International (EQI), the UIL Cairns campus is located within Cairns State High School and is prepared to accept students for the High School Pathway to EQI schools and independent schools in Cairns. General English (GE) and the Secondary School Preparation Program (SSPP) are offered on campus at Cairns State High School. UIL is the only provider in Cairns offering the SSPP program. EQI and UIL's independent school partners in Cairns can issue package offers for prospective students wishing to study SSPP, provided they meet all entry requirements for a package offer.

Sunshine Coast Campus, Queensland

In partnership with Education Queensland International (EQI), the UIL Sunshine Coast campus is ready to take students for EQI Highschool Pathway. Secondary School Preparation Programs (SSPP) are offered on campus at Chancellor State College. EQI can issue package offers for prospective students wishing to study SSSP (please note students need to meet all EQI entry requirements for a package offer to be issued).

Toowoomba Campus, Queensland

As a wholly owned subsidiary of the University of Southern Queensland (UniSQ), UlL's Toowoomba Campus is located within UniSQ and offers a broad range of ELICOS programs, including Secondary School Preparation Programs (SSPP), General English (GE), and English for Academic Purposes (EAP) packages. These pathway programs are delivered through UlL's partnership with UniSQ, to international students on pathways to both EQI and Independent Primary and Secondary Schools in the Toowoomba region.

English Language Programs

School Pathway

School preparation programs prepare students to enter primary, junior or senior secondary school within Australia. UIL is partnered with Education Queensland International (EQI) and multiple independent schools, providing students with a variety of choice when selecting a school that best meets their needs. Primary and secondary school preparation programs consist of 25 hours of study per week with 20 hours in the classroom and 5 hours of "English in Practice" activities. Student progress is reported on every 5 weeks.

Primary School Preparation Program (PSPP)

For students planning to enter primary school. Prepares students for transition to schooling in Australia using an English-speaking context and curriculum.

Secondary School Preparation Program (SSPP)

Intermediate English language level or above, appropriate for 12-18 years old. Starting every Monday. Duration of the program depends on the student's level of English (10 weeks per level).

General English (GE)

Elementary to Advanced Levels (5 levels), 10 weeks per level. General English programs provide a pathway for students preparing for entry into the Secondary School Preparation or English for Academic Purposes programs, as well as development of English language skills and recreational English.

English for Academic Purposes (EAP)

Entry requirement: IELTS 5.0 or equivalent.

3 Levels, 10 weeks each. Provides students with the necessary skills to feel confident to commence studies at tertiary institutions.

- EAP1 Entry into VET or TAFE programs
- EAP 2 Entry into most Bachelor Degree programs
- EAP 3 Entry into some Bachelor Degree programs and Postgraduate Degree programs

Pathway into a UniSQ Degree

UniSQ Foundation Programs aim to equip students with the necessary skills to successfully respond to the numeracy, literacy, critical thinking and e-literacy demands of higher education studies and the professional workplace, in addition to assisting students to successfully manage the complexities of life-work balance.

The program introduces students to university academic culture, offering a solid foundation in key principles, issues, and strategies essential for success in first-year undergraduate studies. The program is available in two formats:

- · Standard Foundation Program
- Extended Foundation Program

Both versions of the program emphasise collaboration, technology, problem-solving, research, and hands-on laboratory work.

Model

The curriculum includes subjects comparable in standard to an Australian Year 12 curriculum and prepares students for study in higher education programmes.

The program is structured to ensure capacity for the future introduction of specialisations. It enables international students to meet the academic and English language requirements (IELTS 6.0 or equivalent) necessary to enter the first year of selected UniSQ Bachelor Degrees.

Articulation

Students will meet the entry requirements to selected UniSQ undergraduate degrees.




Manni DAI – St Aidan's Girls' Anglican School

UIL Support Services

UIL Students Services & Counselling Support

UIL's teaching staff are experienced in assisting students with advice relating to their progress, future study plans and any issues they may encounter during their time in Australia. UIL ensures access to professional counsellors to assist students with any areas of concern.

UIL coordinates an orientation program for each student entering a partner school. This may involve visiting the school and attending classes, staying at the boarding house, joining activities with Australian students and meeting with the school counsellor for subject selections.

Visits to universities and colleges are organised for students to meet with staff to discuss subject selection and participate in orientation programs.

Homestay and Accommodation

UIL manages a homestay program of over 500 families from its Springfield campus. Homestay families are carefully selected to meet UIL's expectations. All homestay families are carefully screened for suitability.

Homestay families assist students getting to their UIL campus on the first day so that they are familiar with travel to and from their homestay location.

Boarding house accommodation is available to students entering one of UIL's partner boarding schools. Boarding houses provide a caring and supportive environment for students preparing to enter an Australian high school.

Students who are 18 years old and over have the option to stay in share accommodation with other students or in apartment accommodation near to their UIL campus.

Airport Transfers

UIL will arrange for a representative to meet with students at the domestic or international airport in Brisbane or the Gold Coast and accompany them to their accommodation or UIL campus.

High school students living in a boarding house of a UIL partner school may be met at the airport by that school's representative.

If students are over 18 and wishing to travel independently to their accommodation, the UIL team will advise them of the most convenient form of transport.

In addition, the UIL airport transfer service is a valuable amenity provided at no cost to UniSQ international students who first arrive in Australia. This service ensures that students arriving from abroad have a worry-free and complimentary transportation option to their accommodation in Ipswich, Springfield, or Toowoomba. It's a thoughtful gesture by UniSQ aimed at easing the transition and welcoming international students to their new academic journey, making their arrival as smooth and cost-effective as possible.
